- That the confidential verbal update from the Deputy City Manager, Planning & Growth Management and the Deputy City Manager, Administrative Services & City Solicitor be received;
- 2) That Legal counsel for the City be directed to advise the LPAT that the City is supportive, in principle, of the redevelopment of the lands for a residential development consisting of 2 6-storey buildings with a maximum FSI of 3;
- That the support of the City referenced in recommendation 2 is contingent upon the LPAT, being requested, on the consent of the City and the Applicant/Appellant, to withhold the final order approving the redevelopment until such time as the official plan

- 5) City Council authorize the public release of the recommendations of the Special Committee of the Whole (Closed Session).
