1. Purpose

The purpose of this Staff Communication is to provide Mayor and Council information regarding the Development Liaison Committee, “think tank”.

2. Analysis

The Development Liaison Committee (DLC) was established in June 2019 to consider and discuss a wide range of topics relating to the city building process.

The mandate of the DLC is to establish a solution-based approach with the development industry in order to provide clarity on how to advance City building (approvals, processes, and policy initiatives) and in a timely manner to meet changing market conditions.

Membership of this new “think tank” was advertised broadly and transparently through the BILD liaison group network and includes a balance of industry expertise ranging from low-rise residential, mid/high rise, mixed-use, commercial and employment use development. Gabe DiMartino, Co-chair of BILD has accepted a committee co-chair role, alternating with the DCM, Planning & Growth Management.

The “think tank” is the first of its kind in York Region and provides for dialogue and information sharing. Members work collaboratively towards mutually acceptable solutions and continuous improvement.

With more than 1,500 member-companies BILD is the voice of the land development, home building and professional renovation industry in the Greater Toronto Area. Our industry is essential to York Regions long-term economic strength and prosperity.
