Purpose

To seek approval for the proclamation requests received for International Archives Day, Longest Day of SMILES and Bike to School Week.

Report Highlights

- Respond to the request received from Operation Smile Canada for June 19, 2022.
- Respond to the request received from Transportation and Fleet Management Services for the week of May 30 to June 3, 2022.

Background

International Archives Day

The EIMS Team has annually celebrated this event by posting information and items from the City's Archives on the City's website as well as on social media platforms. Council approving this proclamation would aid in the awareness and recognition of this date on a larger scale.

Longest Day of SMILES

Operation Smile Canada is a volunteer-based global charity that exists to ensure access to safe and effective cleft surgery. The Longest Day of SMILES campaign is a means to raise awareness and funds to help a child born with a cleft condition smile with free cleft surgery and comprehensive care.

By proclaiming the date of June 19, 2022 as the Longest Day of SMILES in Vaughan, the organization hopes it will raise awareness to provide waiting children with exceptional cleft care and a new smile.

This day was approved to be proclaimed in 2021.

Bike to School Week

Bike to School Week is a province-wide campaign designed to encourage students to travel to school via their bicycles rather than by car. It is an initiative under Active School Travel (a program adopted by local municipalities across Ontario, including Vaughan) to improve physical and mental health and social development.

Bike to School Week along with Active School Travel serves to promote and support active and sustainable transportation options for students. Council's approval of this proclamation is an important component in engaging the community to make healthier and more sustainable choices while travelling to and from school.
