**6. CITY-WIDE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW 001-2021 ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENTS 038-2022 AND 039-2022 REPEAL AND REPLACE TRANSITION PROVISIONS APPEALS TO THE ONTARIO LAND TRIBUNAL**

**The Committee of the Whole (Closed Session) recommends:**

- 1) That the recommendations contained in the report of the Deputy City Manager, Legal and Administrative Services & City Solicitor, dated April 12, 2022, be approved.**

**Recommendations**

2. THAT Council authorize the Deputy City Manager, Legal and Administrative Services and City Solicitor to proceed with settlements of appeals of By-law 039-2022 by way of motion to the OLT if the settlement results in changes that in the opinion of the Deputy City Manager, Legal and Administrative Services and City Solicitor and the Deputy City Manager, Planning and Growth Management, are minor and substantially in accordance with Council's approved intent in By-law 039-2022.
3. THAT Council authorize the Deputy City Manager, Legal and Administrative Services and City Solicitor to take all necessary steps to implement recommendation 2, including the entering into of Minutes of Settlement with appellants on behalf of the City.
4. THAT the City's appeal processing fees for appeals of By-law 039-2022 pursuant to subsection 69(2) of the *Planning Act* be waived for appellants who previously appealed the transition provisions (Section 1.6) of By-law 001-2021, as passed on October 20, 2021.
5. THAT recommendations 2-4 in this Committee of the Whole (Closed Session) report be made public upon Council ratification. Recommendation 1 is to remain confidential.
