


VAUGHAN A094/22 - Notification Map







Proposed Variance(s) (By-law 001-2021):

1. To permit a setback of 0.91 m from the interior side yard for the residential accessory structure.

2. To permit a setback of 0.78 m from the required interior side yard for the retaining wall.

By-Law Requirement(s) (By-law 001-2021):

- 1. The minimum required interior side yard setback for a residential accessory structure that exceeds 2.8 m is 2.4 m.
- 2. A Retaining wall which exceeds 1.0 m shall be setback an equal distance to the height of the highest portion of the retaining wall. Proposed height is 1.38 m.

Proposed Variance(s) (By-law 1-88):

- 3. To permit an interior side yard setback of 0.91 m for the residential accessory structure.
- 4. To permit a setback of 0.78 m from the required interior side yard for the retaining wall.
- 5. To permit the accessory structure in the side yard.

By-Law Requirement(s) (By-law 1-88):

- 3. The minimum required interior side yard setback is 1.5 m for the residential accessory structure.
- 4. A Retaining wall which exceeds 1.0 m shall be setback an equal distance to the height of the highest portion of the retaining wall. Proposed height is 1.38 m.
- 5. An accessory building or structure shall be located in the rear yard.

Official Plan:

City of Vaughan Official Plan 2010 ('VOP 2010'): "Low-Rise Residential"

Comments:

The Owner is requesting to permit the existing retaining wall and the construction of a pergola with the above noted variances.

The Development Planning Department has no objection to Variances 1 and 3 as the reduction to the interior side yard setback for the proposed pergola will not have adverse impacts to the neighbouring properties and maintains an appropriate area for drainage. The proposed pergola will also comply with all height requirements of the Zoning By-law.

The Development Planning Department has no objection to Variances 2 and 4 as the Development Engineering Department has reviewed the existing retaining walls and has assessed that the existing distance between the property line and the retaining walls is sufficient.

The Development Planning Department has no objection to Variance 5 as the proposed pergola is located in what is effectively used as the rear yard and will be screened by the existing fence. The location of the pergola also complies with Zoning By-law 001-2021, which was enacted by Vaughan Council on October 20, 2021, but has been appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal and is not in-effect.

In support of the application, the Owners have submitted a Tree Inventory & Protection Plan prepared by The Urban Arborist Inc., dated March 10, 2022. The report inventoried

30 trees, none of which are proposed to be removed. Urban Design staff have reviewed the report and concur with its recommendations.

Accordingly, the Development Planning Department can support the required variances and is of the opinion that the proposal is minor in nature, maintains the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law, and is desirable for the appropriate development of the land.

Recommendation:

The Development Planning Department recommends approval of the application.
