WHEREAS, the City of Vaughan has existing bird-friendly programs related to threat reduction, habitat protection and restoration, and community outreach and education; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vaughan is pursuing a Bird Friendly City certification through Nature Canada, and celebrating World Migratory Bird Day is a mandatory criterion for certification.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Maurizio Bevilacqua, Mayor of the City of Vaughan, do hereby proclaim the second Saturday in May as World Migratory Bird Day.

The City of Vaughan will recognize World Migratory Bird Day on an annual basis.
