# *BY-LAW*

## BY-LAW NUMBER 128-2022

**A By-law to amend the Dumping By-law 103-2020 to remove provisions related to the requirement to maximum height and clearing of long grass and weeds.**

**WHEREAS** section 11(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 allows municipalities to pass by-laws respecting the environmental well-being of the municipality, and the health and safety of persons;

**AND WHEREAS** the City has brought forward this by-law to manage long grass and weeds in a rapid manner, to mitigate any health, safety and nuisance issues;

**AND WHEREAS** the City endeavors to reduce redundancy of topics across by-laws in order to provide clear regulation;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Amend section 5.0(2) of Dumping By-law 103-2020 so that it now reads as follows:  
“The *Owner* of any *Property* shall clean and clear said *Property* and the *Boulevard* directly adjacent to his or her *Property*.”
