1. PROPOSED RENOVATIONS OF EXISTING BUILDING AT 60 NAPIER STREET IN THE KLEINBURG-NASHVILLE HERITAGE CONSERVATION DISTRICT

The Heritage Vaughan Committee recommended that the following recommendation be forwarded to Council for approval:
