<u>Purpose</u>

To seek Council approval to proclaim September 23 - 29, 2018 as Rail Safety Week, that the CN flag is raised at City Hall on September 26, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. for the balance of Rail Safety Week, and that the proclamation be posted on the City's website and the City Page Online.

Report Highlights

- Respond to the request from the Manager, Public Affairs Ontario of CN Railway, received on April 25, 2018
- Proclamation and flag raising event requested during the week of September 23 – 29, 2018

Recommendations

- 1. That September 23 29, 2018 be proclaimed as Rail Safety Week;
- 2. That the City of Vaughan participate in a flag raising event on September 26, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. for the balance of Rail Safety Week.; and,
- 3. That the proclamation be posted on the City Page Online.

Background

Correspondence was received from the Manager, Public Affairs Ontario of CN Railway on April 25, 2018 in the Office of the City Clerk, requesting a proclamation and flag raising.

The proclamation request was previously granted by Council. The flag raising ceremony is a new, added request from the organization.

Analysis and Options

The proclamation request meets the requirements of the City's Proclamation Policy and Flag Raising/Half Masting Policy, as follows:

"That upon request, the City of Vaughan issue Proclamations for events, campaigns, or other similar matters: If the event, campaign or declaration is directly related to matters over which the City has jurisdictions or the City directly sponsors the event, campaign or other matter".

Rail Safety Week is an important week during which messages about crossing safety and trespass prevention are communicated to millions across North America.

Financial Impact

Broader Regional Impacts/Considerations

The City of Vaughan is home to CN's MacMillan Yard, North America's largest "hump yard", where trains are built to transport goods.

Conclusion

Staff is recommending that September 23 - 29, 2018 be proclaimed as Rail Safety Week, that the CN flag is raised at City Hall on September 26, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. for the balance of Rail Safety Week, and that the proclamation be posted on the City's website and the City Page Online.
