Purpose

Staff is recommending that August 18, 2018 be proclaimed as "India Independence Day" in the City of Vaughan, that the Indian flag be raised at 2:00 p.m. on August 18, 2018 at City Hall for the balance of the day, and that the proclamation be posted on the City Page Online.

Analysis and Options

The proclamation meets the requirements of the City's Proclamation Policy and Flag Raising/Half Masting Policy, as follows:

"That upon request, the City of Vaughan issue Proclamations for events, campaigns, or other similar matters: If the event, campaign or declaration is directly related to matters over which the City has jurisdictions or the City directly sponsors the event, campaign or other matter"; and

"In recognition of the ethnic diversity of the residents of the municipality the City of Vaughan will fly at the Civic Centre the flag of any nation, country or ethnic group on the national day or on the anniversary of a special occasion, upon a written request to the City Clerk submitted one month in advance by that nation, or ethnic group or its representatives."

India's Independence Day is one of three national holidays in India and is observed in all Indian states and union territories. The City of Vaughan and surrounding areas consist of thousands of members of the South Asian community. The celebration of this day in Vaughan would be meaningful to this community.
