**Purpose**

To provide the Older Adult Task Force Findings Report to Council for consideration at the Council meeting of June 19, 2018.

**Report Highlights**

- Establishment of the Task Force, and the appointment of Members of Council was approved at the Council meeting of October 27, 2017.
- Staff recruited for Citizen Members and they were subsequently appointed at the Council meeting of January 30, 2018.
- The last meeting of the Task Force was May 30, 2018, and the Findings Report will be provided at the Council meeting of June 19, 2018, due to the tight timeline between the last meeting and the June 5<sup>th</sup> Committee of the Whole meeting.

## **Background**

At its meeting on October 24, 2017, Council adopted Item 10, Report No. 35 of the Committee of the Whole, entitled "Older Adult Task Force". In so doing, Council approved the establishment of the Older Adult Task Force, its Terms of Reference, and appointed Councillor DeFrancesca, Regional Councillor Ferri and Regional Councillor Singh to the Task Force.

The mandate of the Task Force is to make recommendations on the implementation of action items related to Vaughan's Older Adult Strategy, including exploring opportunities to move towards an age-friendly community and promotion of healthy seniors. The Terms of Reference dictate that the Task Force submit its Findings Report prior to June 30, 2018.

Recruitment was undertaken for six (6) citizen members and one (1) representative from a senior's organization. Advisory and technical staff support for the Task Force was provided by representatives from the City's Community Development and Transportation Engineering departments, as well as from Fire and Rescue Services, Vaughan Public Libraries, York Region Community and Health Services, and the York Catholic District School Board.
