BY-LAW NUMBER 233-2022

A By-law to dedicate certain lands as part of the public highway and to repeal By-law 79-81.

WHEREAS Section 31 of *the Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 confers that land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law establishing the highway and not by the activities of the municipality or any other person in relation to the land.

WHEREAS on April 6, 1981, the Council of the then Town of Vaughan enacted By-law 79-81 dedicating Part of Reserve Block 19, Plan M-1943 as public highway known as Ashbridge Circle.

WHEREAS it has been determined that the entirety of Reserve Block 19, Plan M-1943 should be dedicated as a public highway known as Ashbridge Circle.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 79-81 is hereby repealed.
2. The lands which are situate in the City of Vaughan, in the Regional Municipality of York, being Reserve Block 19 on Plan M-1943, registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of York Region (No.65) be and they are hereby dedicated as part of public highway known as “Ashbridge Circle”.
