It is my understanding they are building a new 2 pad rink at the centre and are seeking some minor variances to move forward.

As a single mother of 2 girls, I am thrilled to hear we will have a new arena so close to our house and fully support this project. My girls love to skate and when I last visited the Schwartz Reisman Centre to inquire about the project, I was informed that there is a plan to have public skating hours open to ALL Vaughan Residents and not just SRC members.

You may be aware but in addition to a lack of ice time and arenas in this city, there is certainly a lack of public skating hours available. It would be incredible to have the opportunity to get my daughters on the ice so close to him. It seems the minor variances they are looking for, are quite minuscule compared to the overall net benefit this project will have on the city and specifically residents of this immediate area.

Considering all the other options of things that could be built on the site (plazas, housing etc), this seems like by far the best option for our neighbourhood.
