BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 241-2022

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend Encroachment By-law 034-2017, as amended.

WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 ("*Municipal Act*"), as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS subsection 8(1) of the *Municipal Act* provides that the powers of a municipality under this Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Council has determined that it is desirable to make amendments to By-law 034-2017 to change the time the Notice is deemed to be delivered by mail;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Encroachment By-law 034-2017, as amended, be further amended by repealing subsection 3.0(1)(q) and replacing it with the following:

"Notice" means any notice required to be given by the *City* to the *Owner* with respect to this By-law, such *Notice* shall either delivered or sent by prepaid registered mail to the *Owner's* address, as provided to the *City's* Clerk's Department. A *Notice* includes an order issued under sections 444 and 445 of the *Municipal Act*, as amended. In the event such *Notice* is mailed, it is deemed delivered on the fifth business day after mailing;
