BY-LAW NUMBER 244-2022

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to repeal Pesticide By-law 88-2008, as amended.

WHEREAS subsection 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (“*Municipal Act*”), as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality under this Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality’s ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS subsection 7.1(5) of the *Pesticides Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.11*, as amended, provides that a municipal by-law is inoperative if it addresses the use, sale, offer for sale or transfer of a pesticide that may be used for a cosmetic purpose;

AND WHEREAS Council has determined that it is desirable to make repeal By-law 88-2008 in line with provincial regulations;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Pesticide By-law 88-2008, as amended, be repealed.
