BY-LAW NUMBER 247-2022

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to repeal Wrecking Yards By-law 2549-1961, as amended.

WHEREAS subsection 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (“*Municipal Act*”), as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality under this Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality’s ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS section 4.16 8. of City of Vaughan Zoning By-law, as amended, prohibits outside storage for construction waste, motor vehicle wrecking, scrap lumber, scrap iron or other materials, or a junk yard in all zones in the City;

AND WHEREAS Council has determined that it is desirable to repeal By-law 2549-1961 for purposes of alignment with the City’s zoning regulations;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Wrecking Yards By-law 2549-1961, as amended, be repealed.
