#### **Purpose**

To seek approval for the proclamation requests received for Amyloidosis Awareness Month and Reena's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

- Respond to the request received from Reena for the date of January 18, 2023.

### **Recommendations**

#### **Background**

#### **Amyloidosis Awareness Month**

The CASN is a federally registered non-profit organization that assists patients and families impacted by amyloidosis. As per information from CASN, amyloidosis refers to a group of diseases caused by deposits of abnormal proteins, known as amyloid, in one or more organs of the body causing organ impairment or failure.

The organization is working on an awareness campaign to recognize March 2023 as Amyloidosis Awareness Month. March is internationally recognized by the Amyloidosis Foundation to raise awareness.

#### Reena's 50th Anniversary

Reena is celebrating its' 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2023. The organization was started in 1973 and has become a large and influential support service agency in the developmental and mental health sector.

As per information provided by the organization, Reena promotes dignity, individuality, independence, personal growth and community inclusion for people with diverse abilities. Reena provides supportive housing, programming and employment services to over 1,000 individuals with developmental disabilities including autism and those with mental health challenges.

### **Previous Reports/Authority**

Proclamations related to the Reena organization have been granted in past years.
