ACTION: DECISION

Purpose

To enable the City of Vaughan to celebrate the local economy and economic development, the Economic Development department is seeking approval of a list of significant provincially, nationally, and internationally recognized days of significance for entrepreneurs, businesses and stakeholders.

Report Highlights

- Raising the profile of the local economy and undertaking marketing and promotional efforts about Vaughan to attract and retain investments is a key pillar of economic development.
- Engaging in provincial, national, and international opportunities for economic development is a vital way to advance this strategic initiative.

Recommendations

1. THAT Council proclaim the events listed in Table “A” as celebrations in the City of Vaughan; and,
2. THAT Council direct the Office of Communications and Economic Development to use corporate channels where appropriate to communicate the listed economic development-related celebrations.

Background

Through its Economic Development department (ED), the City of Vaughan works to profile and support Vaughan's transformative, ambitious, and purpose-driven economy to make Vaughan a place where entrepreneurship, business, tourism, and art can prosper and grow.

ED's strategic objectives, as detailed in its 2020-2023 Strategic Business Plan, are to:

- Enable a climate for businesses to grow, prosper and create jobs.
- Advance economic opportunities and attract new investment.
- Enrich Vaughan's communities and economy through public art development.
- Effectively pursue service excellence.

ED is preparing a 2023-2027 economic development action plan for Council approval in Q2, 2023.

Vaughan remains a destination of choice for investment, and a major regional economic driver as the largest economy and employment centre in York Region, outpacing regional, provincial, and national economic growth rates: despite revolving public health measures, supply chain impacts, and increasing inflation, Vaughan's economy exceeded pre-pandemic growth in 2021.

Vaughan remains the largest economy in York Region, contributing 37.5 per cent of all economic output in the Region. Vaughan accounts for more than half of the Region's real GDP in good-producing industries and nearly one-third of its real GDP in service-producing industries. In 2021, Vaughan's GDP approached \$25 Billion.

Various organizations recognize businesses and the economy with designated days and weeks to educate, mobilize, and celebrate.

An important part of growing the local economy is to celebrate its successes and contributions to society. The United Nations (UN), for example, leads many international celebrations. They remind us that:

- “International days are occasions to educate the general public on issues of concern, to mobilize political will and resources to address global problems, and to celebrate and reinforce achievements of humanity.”¹

Analysis and Options

The City of Vaughan provides best-in-class services to one of Canada’s most dynamic economies: the services and economy can be celebrated to raise the City of Vaughan’s profile as a destination of choice for business through Council-endorsed provincial, national, and international days and weeks.

In 2021 ED staff exemplified service excellence, helping our businesses to yield meaningful results as they:

- Delivered 814 business advisory consultations.
- Answered more than 3,150 inquiries.
- Provided 78 webinars to more than 1,500 participants.
- Assisted the start or growth of 239 businesses.
- Facilitated a total of 32 pre-qualified site-selection inquiries.

ED was further recognized for its outstanding efforts in its economic development efforts. The City has been recognized with the following awards:

Furthermore, Vaughan's unemployment rate was 7.8 per cent in 2021, a 1.3 per cent decrease from the previous year and below the regional and provincial rates. Vaughan's labour force participation rate was 74 per cent in 2021. In addition, the City's economy is growing at a rate above the national average.

To further raise the profile of Vaughan's economy, ED recommends that Council endorse the following government and public sector celebrations, thereby having the City of Vaughan participate in conversations across the globe.
