The Applicant is requesting permission to recognize seven (7) the parking spaces onsite to service an eating establishment, take-out and reduce the minimum parking space dimensions of four of the parking spaces with the above noted variances.

Development Planning has no objection to the Variances. The reduction in parking spaces is appropriate in this site context as the Subject Lands are within a Local Centre (Historic Thornhill Village) where various forms of high order transit (i.e. VIVA & York Region bus routes, and proposed Yonge St. subway expansion) support pedestrian and transit oriented travel. In addition, Transportation Engineering has confirmed: (1) 7 parking spaces are adequate to service the eating establishment, take-out, and (2) the four 2.6 x 4.8 m parking spaces may be considered compact motor vehicle parking spaces. Compact motor vehicle parking spaces are permitted through Comprehensive Zoning By-law 001-2021. It should be noted the four spaces must be marked and adequate signage need to be installed to inform future users/customers.

As the Subject Lands are within Thornhill Heritage Conservation District and zoned "NC – Neighbourhood Commercial" by Comprehensive Zoning By-law 001-2021, any changes to the building(s)/site require a Heritage Permit and are subject to Site Plan Control. For clarity, the approval of this minor variance application does not absolve the Owner from other uses or alterations that were done without the consent and approval of the City.

The Development Planning Department is of the opinion that the requested Variances are minor in nature, maintain the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law, and are desirable for the appropriate development of the land.

Recommendation:

The Development Planning Department recommends approval of the application.
