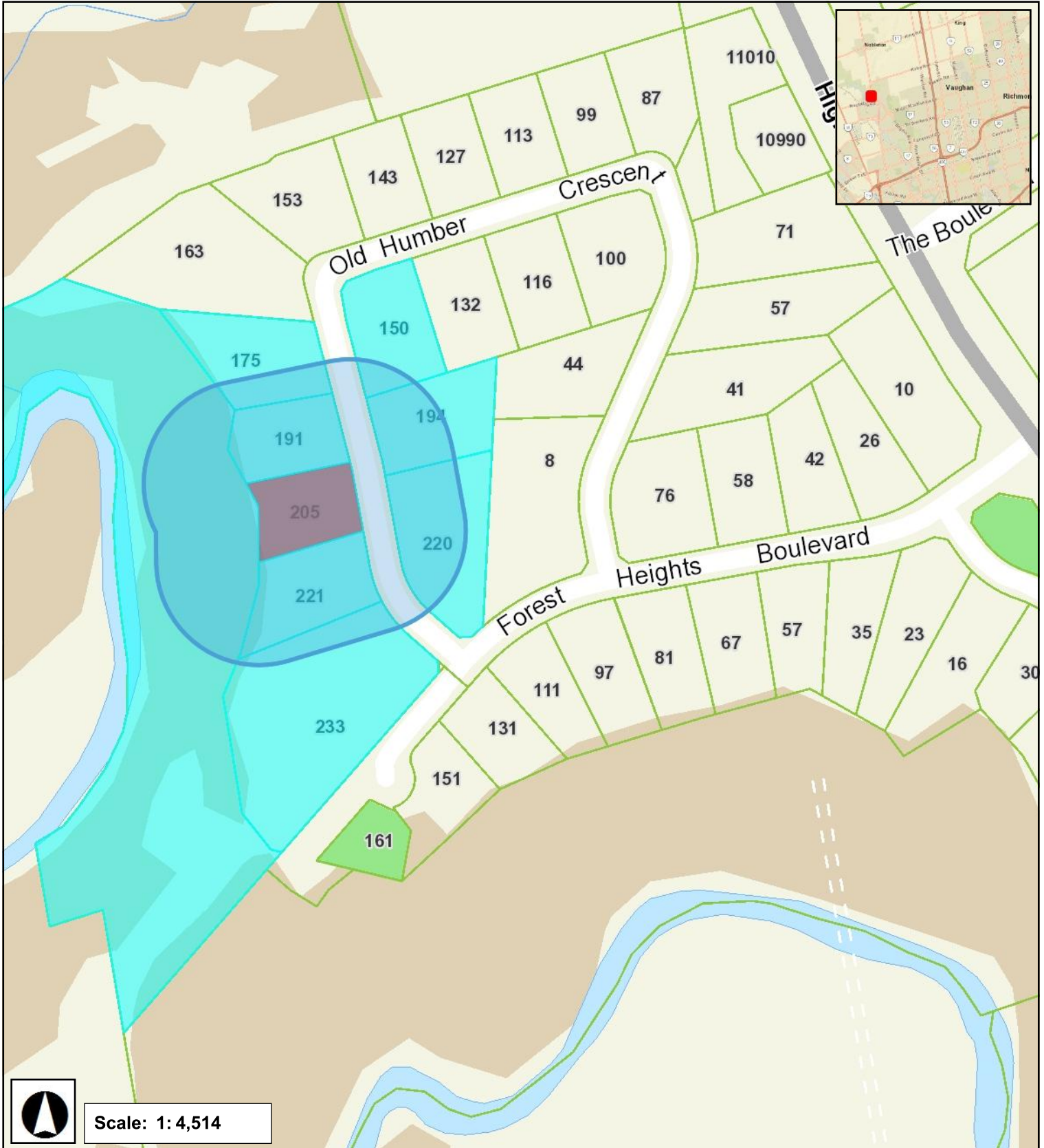

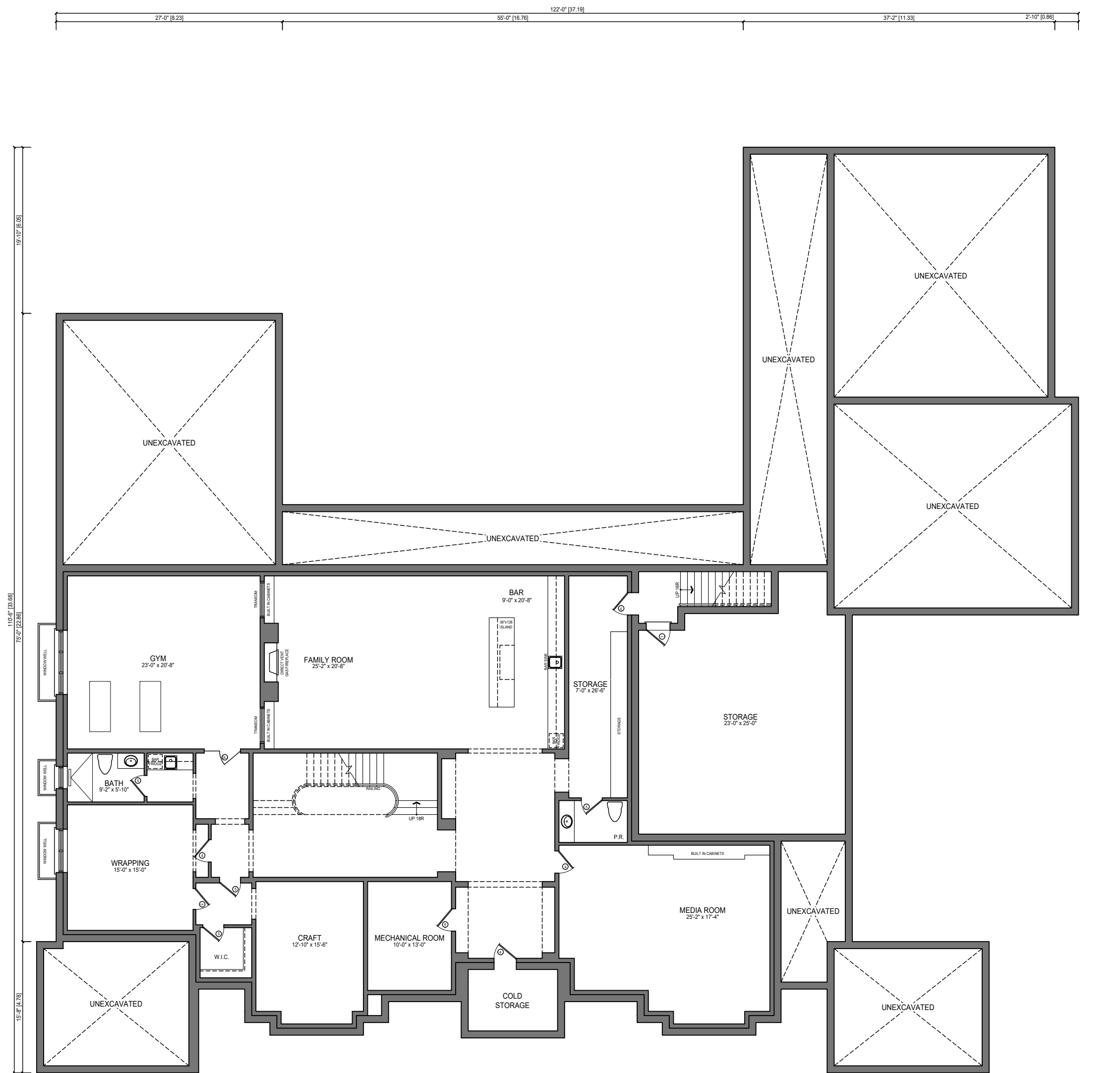

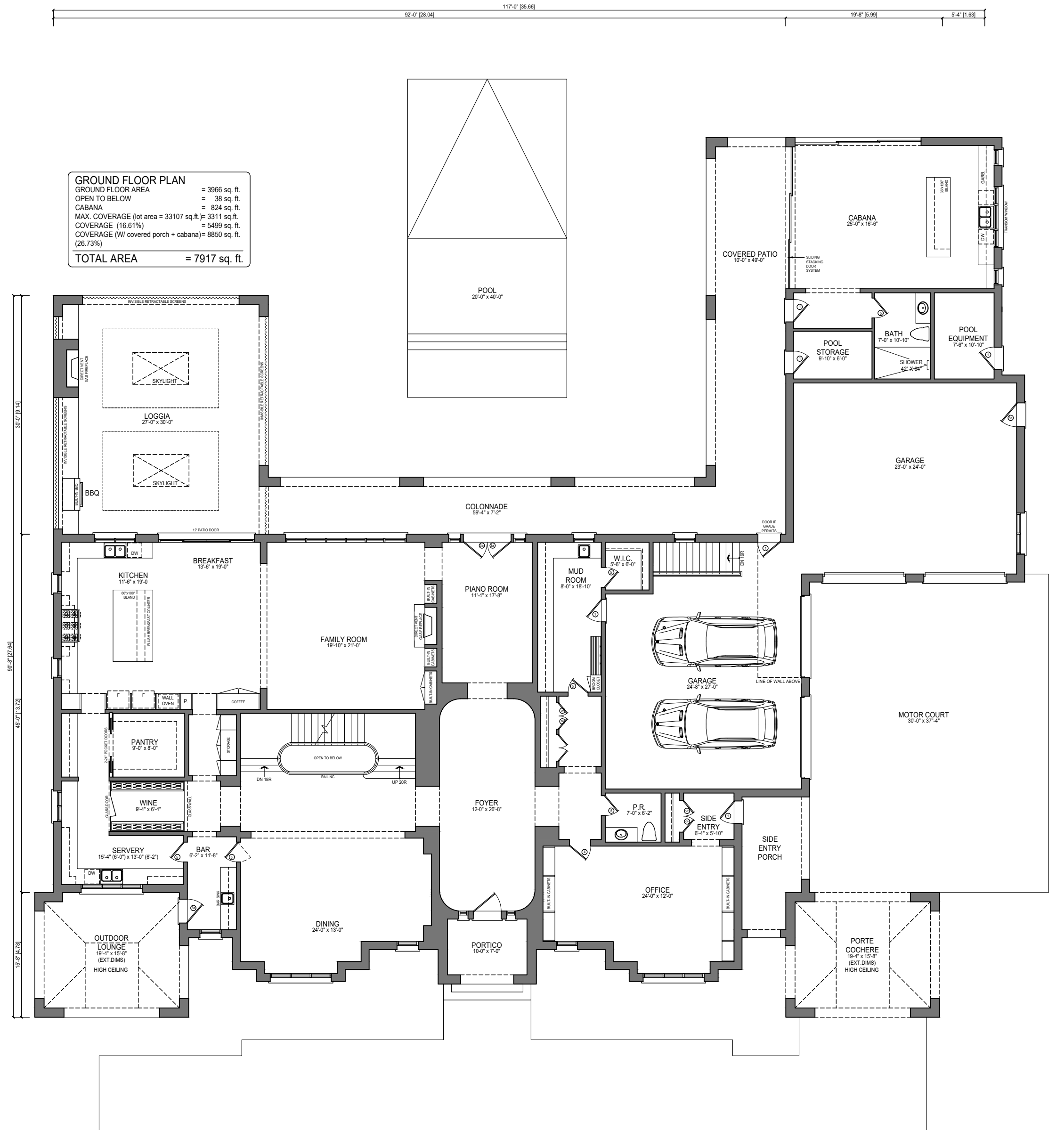

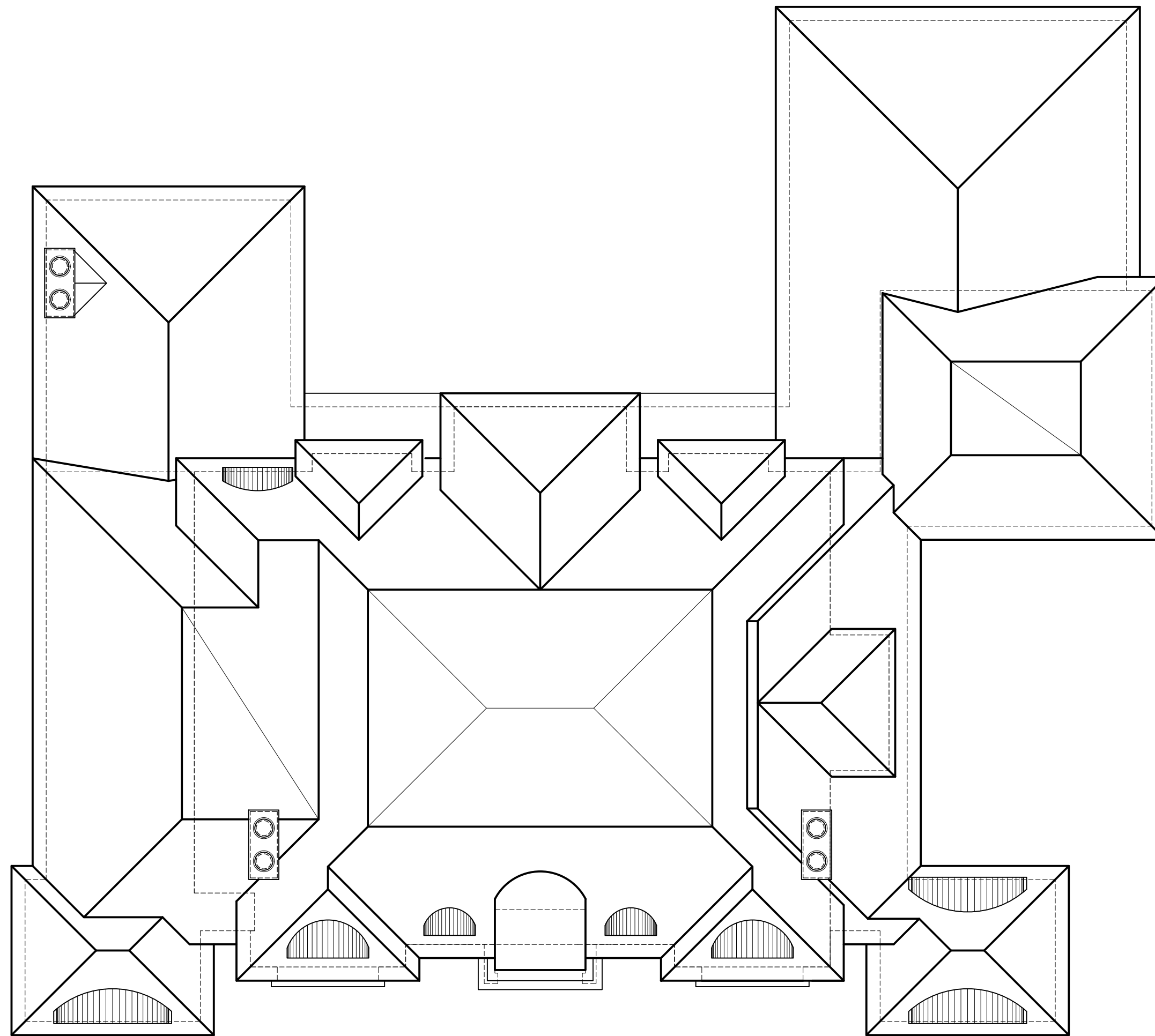


SECOND FLOOR PLAN
