Applicant has advised that they cannot comply with By-law for the following reason(s): Size of backyard is very small and necessitates moving pool back to side as client will need wheel chair access.

A Building Permit has not been issued. The Ontario Building Code requires a building permit for structures that exceed 10m2.

A permit shall be obtained from the Engineering Department for the proposed swimming pool.

Applicant has confirmed that the pool equipment will be ground-mounted and not covered in a structure.

The applicant shall be advised that additional variances may be required upon review of detailed drawing for building permit.

The subject lands may be subject to the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Act, RSO 2001.

Relief granted from the City's Zoning By-law is determined to be the building envelope considered and approved by the Committee of Adjustment.

Development outside of the approved building envelope (subject to this application) must comply with the provisions of the City's Zoning By-law or additional variances may be required.

Elevation drawings are provided to reflect the style of roof to which building height has been applied (i.e. flat, mansard, gable etc.) as per By-law 1-88 and the Committee of Adjustment approval. Please note, that architectural design features (i.e. window placement), that do not impact the style of roof approved by the Committee, are not regulated by this decision.

Conditions

It is the responsibility of the owner/applicant and/or authorized agent to obtain and provide a clearance letter from respective department and/or agency. This letter must be provided to the Secretary-Treasurer to be finalized. All conditions must be cleared prior to the issuance of a Building Permit.



Location Map Sketches










All proposed billboards, signs, and other structures associated with the project or plan must maintain minimum clearances to the existing overhead or underground electrical distribution system as specified by the applicable standards, codes and acts referenced.

In the event that construction commences, and the clearance between any component of the work/structure and the adjacent existing overhead and underground electrical distribution system violates the Occupational Health and Safety Act, the customer will be responsible for 100% of the costs associated with Alectra making the work area safe.
