# <u>TITLE</u>: OPPORTUNITIES TO IMPROVE THE CITY'S COYOTE RESPONSE AND CO-EXISTENCE STRATEGY

#### FROM:

*Whereas,* the City has adopted a Coyote Response and Co-existence Strategy in 2022 in order to reduce human-coyote conflicts while prioritizing human safety; and

**Whereas,** the City is undertaking an educational outreach strategy to residents in order to mitigate dangerous encounters with Coyotes; and

**Whereas,** Coyotes have flexible social behaviour, it is imperative for the City to ensure its Response and Co-existence strategy is proven to be effective.

#### It is therefore recommended:

- That the Deputy City Manager, Community Services report back to Council, no later than Q3 of 2023, with a status update on the effectiveness of the City's Coyote Response and Co-existence Strategy since its inception; and
- That the Deputy City Manager, Community Services report back to Council on the existing provincial legislation, and how the city can make improvements to its strategy within that framework.
