Background

International Archives Day

The EIMS Team has annually celebrated this event by posting information and items from the City's Archives on the City's website, as well as on social media platforms. Council previously approved this proclamation request in 2022.

Emergency Preparedness Week

This week is a national event involving all levels of government working together to reinforce to citizens the importance of being prepared for any situation. This week is an opportunity for residents to take inventory of items in their homes to prepare for emergency situations, reflect on how they have successfully managed past emergency situations, and strengthen capabilities to handle future emergencies.
