





Given the generous size of the lot, the substantial vegetative screening in the side and rear yards, and the scale of the residential dwellings on the abutting lots, the increased height will not pose a significant massing impact to the surrounding properties, nor impact the function of the abutting uses.

Accordingly, the Development Planning Department can support the requested variance and is of the opinion that the proposal is minor in nature, maintains the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law, and is desirable for the appropriate development of the land.

This letter acknowledges receipt of the above-noted application circulated by the City of Vaughan. The materials were received by Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) on July 27, 2023. TRCA staff have reviewed the application and offer the following comments for the consideration of the Committee of Adjustment.

#### **Purpose of the Application**

It is our understanding that the purpose of the above noted application is to request the following variance under By-Law 001-2021:

To permit a maximum height of 4.01 m for a residential accessory structure, whereas a
maximum height of an accessory building and residential accessory structure shall be 3.0
metres.

The noted variance is being requested to facilitate the construction of a gazebo at the rear of the existing residential dwelling.

#### **Ontario Regulation 166/06**

The subject property is located within TRCA's Regulated Area due to a valley corridor associated with a tributary of the Don River and an unevaluated wetland. In accordance with Ontario Regulation 166/06 (Regulation of Development, Interference with Wetlands and Alterations to Shorelines and Watercourses), development, interference or alteration may be permitted in the Regulated Area where it can be demonstrated to TRCA's satisfaction that the control of flooding, erosion, dynamic beaches, pollution, or the conservation of land will not be affected.

#### **Application-Specific Comments**

As noted above, the subject property is regulated by TRCA due to the presence of a valley corridor and unevaluated wetland.

TRCA policies require a 6 metre setback from the furthest limit of a valley corridor for non-habitable accessory structures (i.e., pools, sheds, decks, landscaping, etc.). Based on a review of the materials submitted with this minor variance application, TRCA staff are satisfied that the proposed works are appropriately set back from the adjacent valley corridor and wetland. As such TRCA staff have no objections to the requested variance.

A permit pursuant to Ontario Regulation 166/06 is required for the proposed works. A list of the materials required to initiate the permit application process are included in Appendix 'A'.

#### Fees

By copy of this letter, the applicant is advised that the TRCA has implemented a fee schedule for our planning application review services. This application is subject to a \$660.00 (Minor Variance – Residential - Minor) review fee. The applicant is responsible for fee payment and should forward the application fee to this office as soon as possible.

#### Recommendations

Based on the comments noted above, TRCA has no objection to the approval of Minor Variance Application A114.23 subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the applicant provides the required fee amount of \$660.00 payable to the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority.
- 2. That the applicant obtains a permit for the proposed works within the Regulated Area pursuant to Ontario Regulation 166/06.
