# ***BY-LAW***

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 142-2023**

**A By-law to amend Parking By-law 064-2019, to provide greater clarity on the distance a motorist may park from a Fire Hydrant.**

**WHEREAS** section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on a municipality to (a) enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and (b) enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** section 11(3) and 11(8) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide for lower-tier municipalities to pass by-laws respecting matters pertaining to highways, including parking and traffic on highways, and parking, except on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** staff seek to provide greater clarity with respect to the distance that a motorist is required to park from a hydrant;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In Parking By-law 064-2019, as amended, to delete section 5.0(8) and replace it with the following: “No person shall *Park a Motor Vehicle* within three (3) metres of the point on the edge of the roadway nearest any fire hydrant.”.
