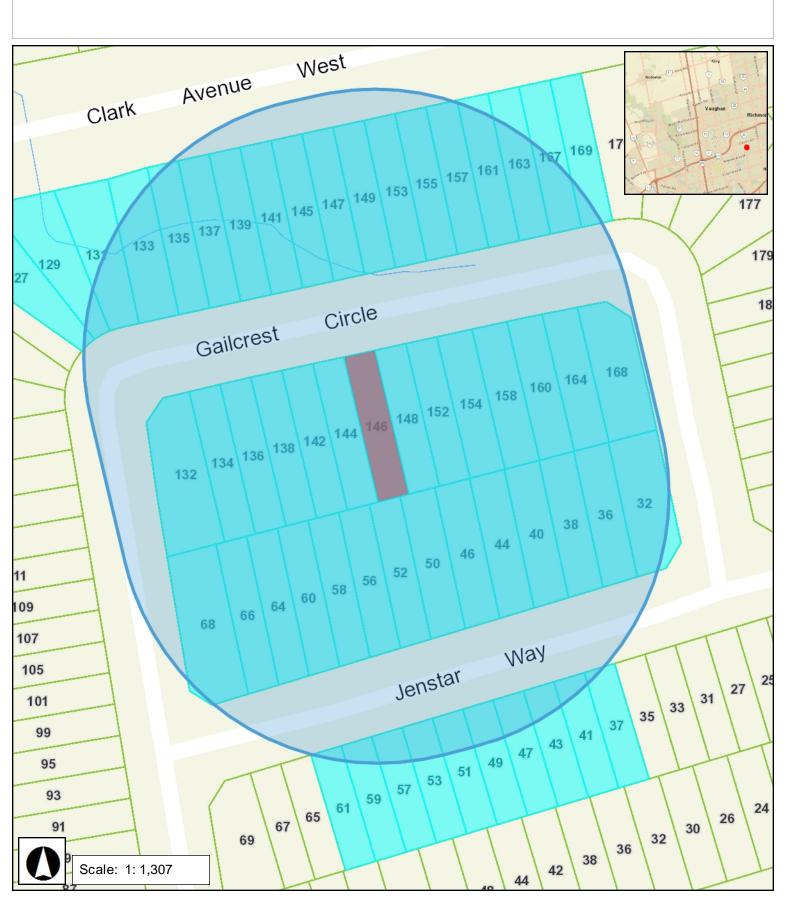

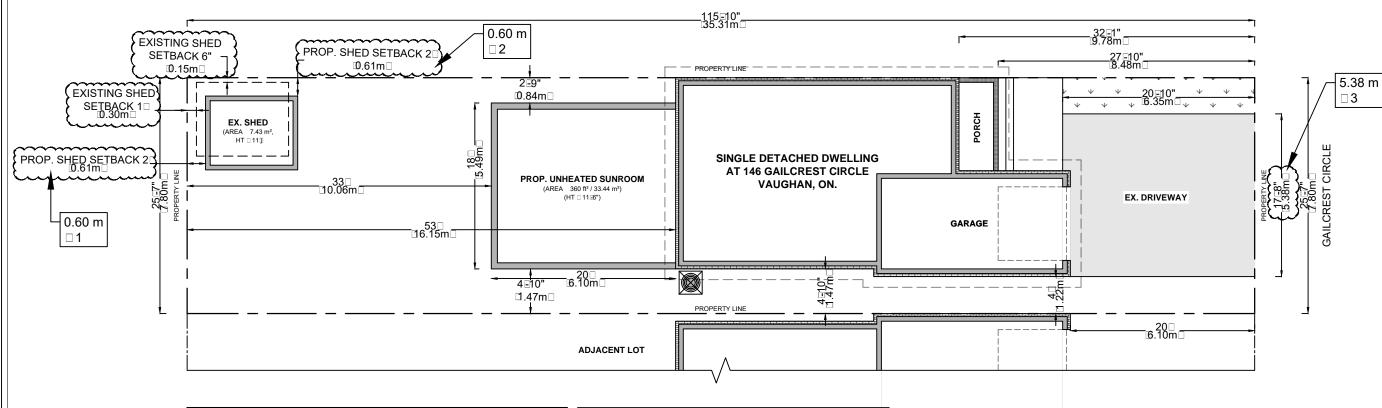
VAUGHAN Location Map - A146/23

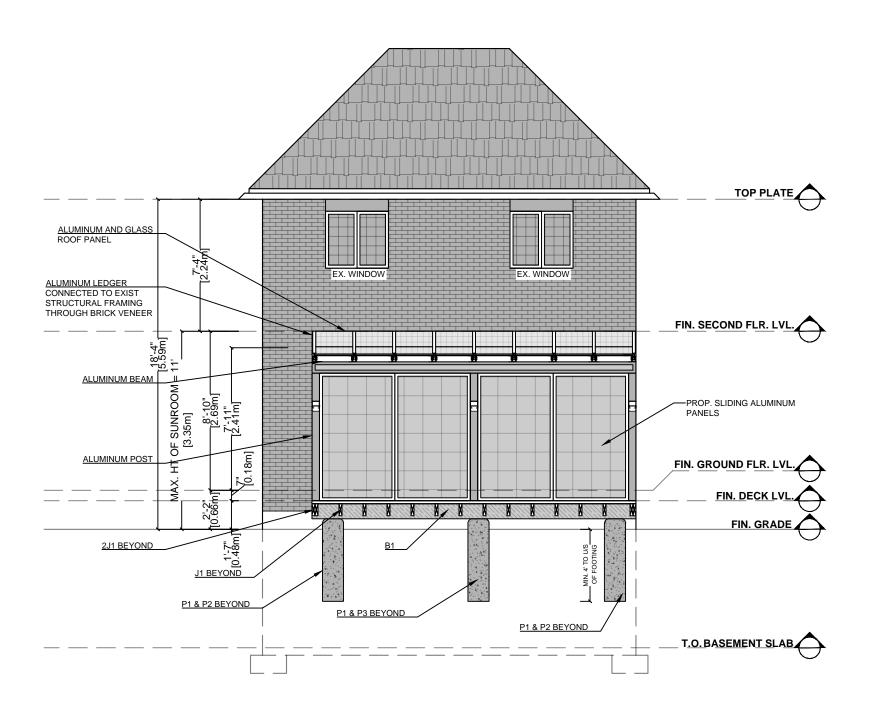

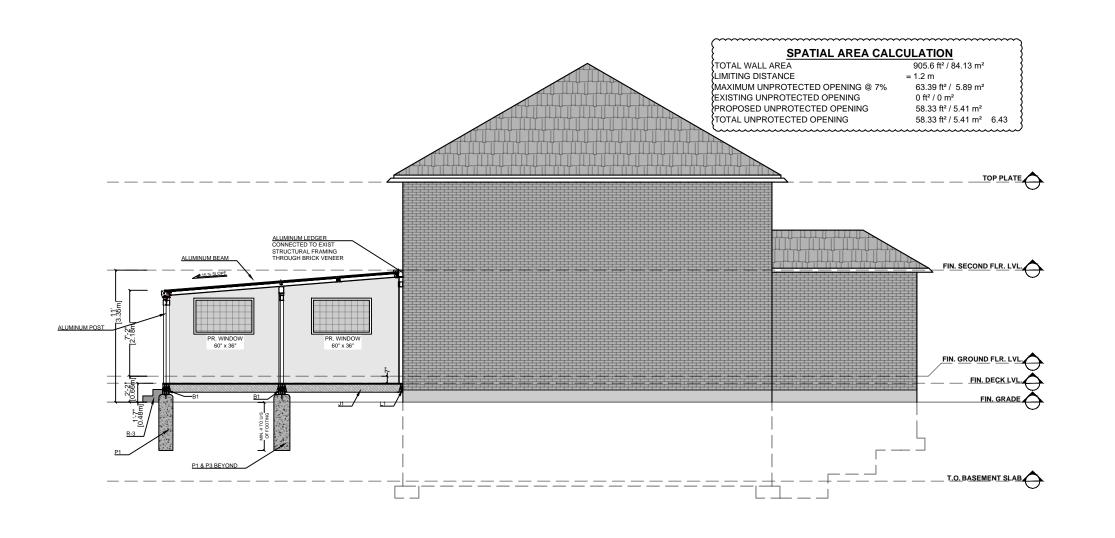

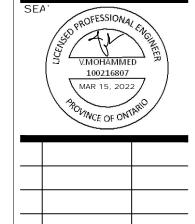
