Weston Consulting is the authorized planning agent for Hunter-Langstaff Developments Inc., the registered owner of the lands legally described as Part Lot 11, Concession 10 as in VA61251, Except Part 5 65R27879, Vaughan (PIN 03319-0042) (herein referred to as the "Subject Lands" or "Servient Lands"). The purpose of this Consent application is to create an easement in favour of the adjoining parcel to the east for access over a mutual driveway (Part 3 of the enclosed Draft Reference Plan) and to provide access for maintenance of a concrete toe wall along the eastern property lot line (Part 4 of the enclosed Draft Reference Plan).

Description of Subject Lands

The Subject Lands are located along the north side of Langstaff Road, between Highway 50 and Huntington Road (Figure 1) and have an approximate lot area of 39,312.56 square metres and a frontage of approximately 152.75 along Langstaff Road. The lot is currently vacant, and is situated within Block 64 South, a largely undeveloped unemployment area which is intended to be developed for general and prestige employment uses.

Applications History

The parcel to the east is currently being developed and has obtained Site Plan Approval (DA.20.053) to permit two multi-unit industrial buildings with ground floor accessory offices and surface parking spaces. Recently, the approved Site Plan for the adjoining parcel to the east has been amended, through a Minor Site Plan Amendment application to propose a revision to the site access from Langstaff Road to accommodate a shared access with the Subject Lands. The purpose of this easement application is to provide for this shared access and maintenance of a toe wall.

Purpose and Justification of Proposed Consent

The purpose of the Consent application is to facilitate an easement in favour of the adjoining parcel to the east, municipally known as 8554 Huntington Road, located at the northwest intersection of Huntington Road and Langstaff Road (herein after referred to as the "Dominant Lands").

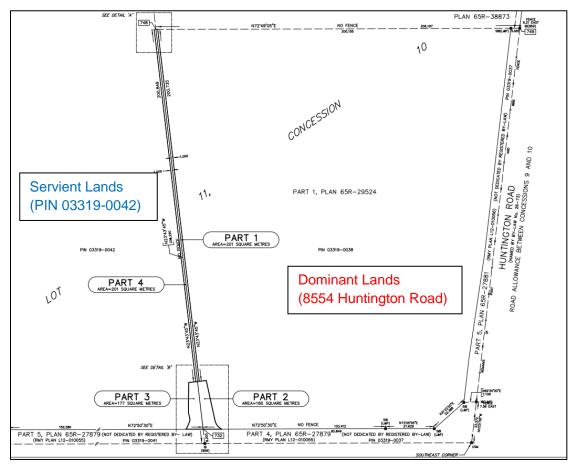


Figure 2. Draft Reference Plan

A Draft Reference Plan is attached to this letter identifying the location of the proposed easement in relation to the Subject Lands. The proposed easement is located at the entrance to the Subject Lands from Langstaff Road, identified as Part 3 and the purpose is to provide access to the dominant lands (Figure 2). Additionally, the easement also includes Part 4 of the Servient Lands, in favour of the dominant lands for access for maintenance of a concrete toe wall along the shared property line (Figure 2).

The following is a summary of the proposed easements:

- Part 3, owned by Part Lot 11 Concession 10 (PIN 03319-0042) (servient lands) granting an easement in favor of 8554 Huntington Road (dominant lands) for access. The total area of Part 3 is 177 square metres.
- Part 4, owned by Part Lot 11 Concession 10 (PIN 03319-0042) (servient lands) granting an
 easement in favor of 8554 Huntington Road (dominant lands) for maintenance access of a
 concrete toe wall. The total area of Part 3 is 201 square metres.

It should be noted a Consent application on behalf of the adjoining owner to the east (8554 Huntington Road / Servient Lands) is being submitted to grant an easement over Parts 1 and 2 in favour of the Subject Lands.

It is our opinion that the proposed easement has appropriate regard for the *Planning Act*. The proposed easement will facilitate access to the dominant lands and maintenance access for the toe wall, which demonstrates appropriate regard for ss. 2 (f) regarding the adequate provision and efficient use of transportation services and infrastructure as a matter of provincial interest. This easement would enable the efficient use of a singular, shared driveway for vehicular access. Furthermore, the Consent application has regard for Section 53 of the *Planning Act*.

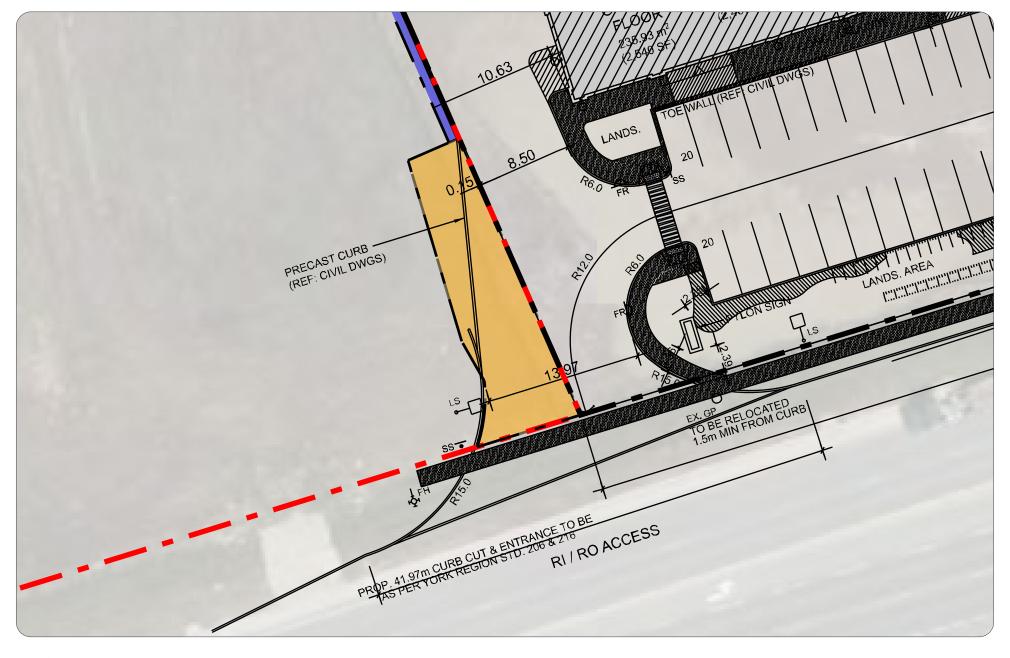


PROPOSED EASEMENTS (PART LOT 10, CON 11)



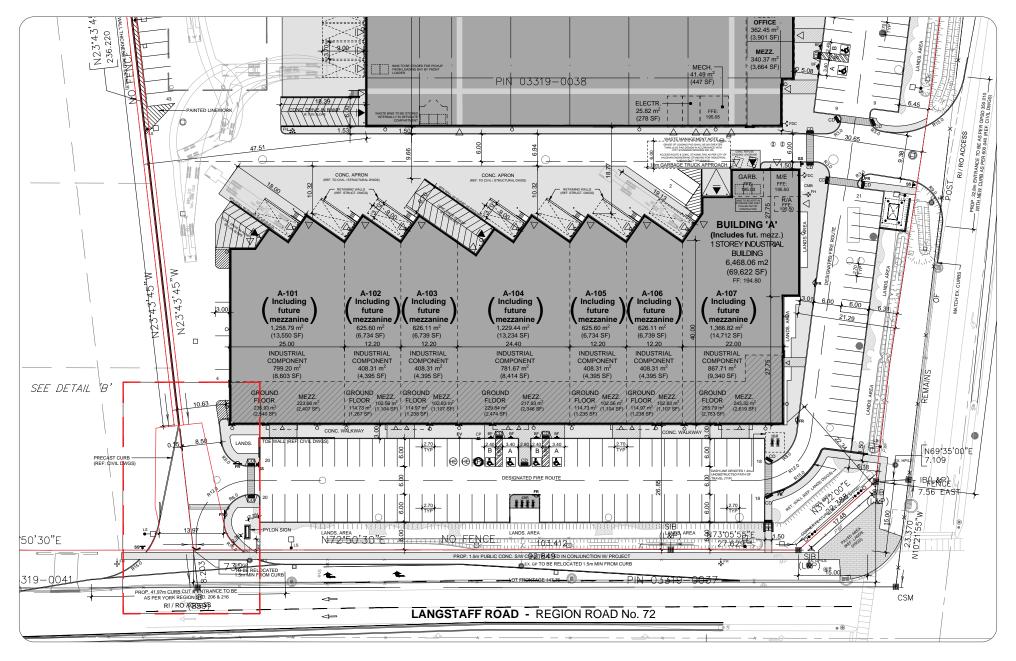


PROPOSED EASEMENTS (PART LOT 10, CON 11)



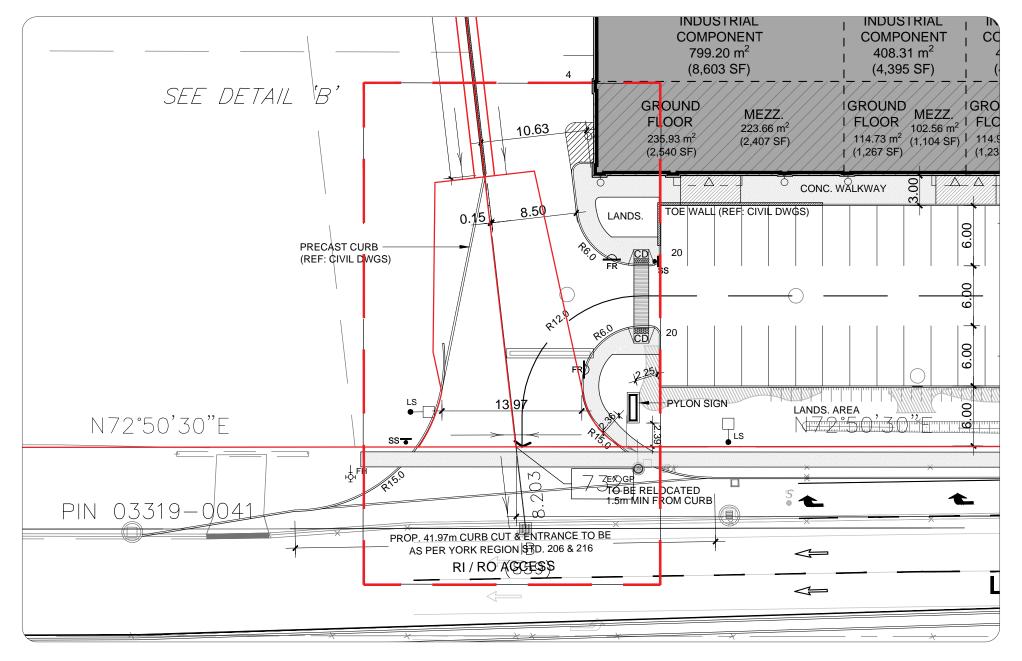


PROPOSED EASEMENTS (8554 HUNTINGTON ROAD)
