To seek approval for the proclamation request received for Wear Red Canada Day.

Background

The request for proclamation was received from the Canadian Women's Heart Health Centre in the Office of the City Clerk on August 8, 2023.

As per information provided by the requestor, heart disease is the number one killer of women worldwide and the leading cause of premature death in women in Canada. Wear Red Canada Day is celebrated annually across Canada on February 13 to raise awareness about women's cardiovascular health.
