BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 156-2023

A By-law to amend the Animal Control By-law 066-2020 to prohibit new Pigeon licences to be issued by the City.

WHEREAS paragraph 9 of subsection 11(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that a lower-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting animals;

AND WHEREAS the City of Vaughan wishes to prohibit the issuance of any new licences to keep pigeons due to public health concerns about the current Avian Influenza pandemic, however, believe existing licence holders should be able to retain their licences for humanitarian reasons;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In Animal Control By-law 066-2020, to delete the current text in 16.0(2) and replace it with, “As of October 17, 2023, the *Chief Licensing Officer* shall not approve any new *Pigeon Licences*; however, existing *Pigeon Licence* holders may renew their licences which includes payment of the applicable fee as set out in *Fees and Charges By-law* 171-2013, as amended or its successor by-law, and lawfully keep their pigeons until their birds’ deaths.”
2. In Animal Control By-law 066-2020, to delete the current text in 16.0(3) and replace it with, “A *Pigeon Licence* holder must be a member of the Canadian Racing Pigeon Union or the Canadian Pigeon Fanciers’ Association.”.
