I Donald Cameron was born & brought up in Baramolach
Parish of Kilmichel Glasrie. Argyll, N. B.

My Father's name Archibald. My Mother's name
Agnes my Gran Father's name was Duncan my Mother's
Father's name was William Cameron. Both my
Gran Mothers died before I was born. so that I am
not sure of their given name. I think my Father's
Mother's name was Crawford my Mother's Mother was
Mac Nidge.

My Father's occupation was that of a Herd in Baramolach
and my Grand Father till his death after the death of
my Grand Father Duncan, my Father ^{had} the whole charge
of the Farm, very often buying & selling for his master
and I the oldest of our family helping him according
to my strength.

Till he thought he could spare me and sent me to
service. he hired me with M^r Alex^r Campbell of
Ederline for £4 sterling for half a year I was then in
my 15th years. M^r Alex^r was a very kind master to me
and all the rest of the servants was likewise very kind to
me some of them my school meats. I had the charge
of cattle & sheep - a very laborious task however
I put in my time which would be up at Martinmas
then I went home and went to school during the
winter season; my Father was to live Baramolach
