BY-LAW NUMBER 191-2023

A By-law of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend Fees and Charges By-law 010-2023, as amended, to remove licensing fees for towing businesses.

WHEREAS subsection 11(3)11. of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25* (“*Municipal Act*”), as amended, provides that a lower-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting business licensing;

AND WHEREAS subsection 391(1)(a) of the *Municipal Act* provides for the municipality to impose fees or charges on persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan has determined that it is desirable to make amendments to City’s Fees and Charges By-law 010-2023, as amended, to remove licensing fees for towing businesses;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Fees and Charges By-law 010-2023, as amended, be further amended by repealing the following licensing fees from Schedule N:

Tow Truck Authorization Book
Tow Truck Brokerage
Tow Truck Driver
Tow Truck Owners

Force and Effect

- 2. This By-law shall come into force and effect on January 1, 2024.
