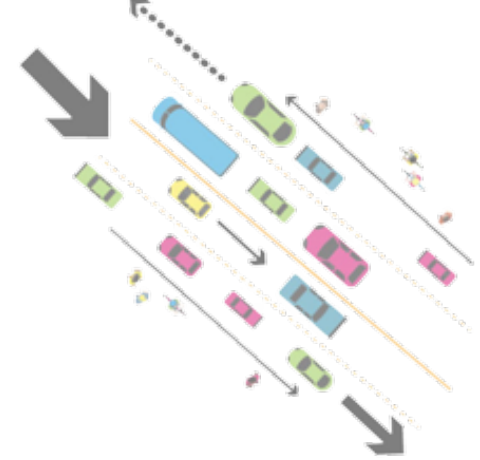

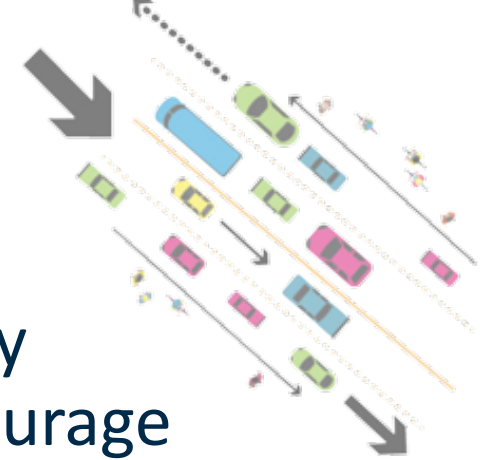

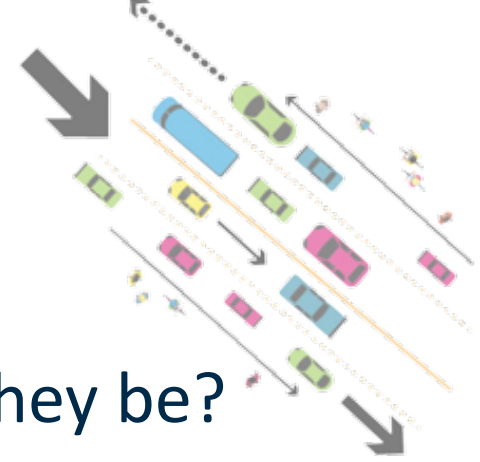
# Mandate

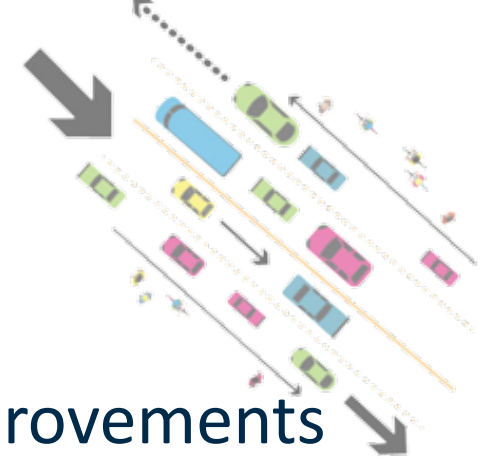


If you could make a few big changes in Vaughan, what would they be?
