Applicant has advised that they cannot comply with By-law for the following reason(s):

Cannot comply with zoning by-law because the proposed pool is at the rear of the existing dwelling but due to a technicality, the front lot line is not in front of the dwelling but on the side of the dwelling. Consequently, the proposed pool is located in the "side yard".

Committee of Adjustment recommended conditions of approval: None

Building Standards (Zoning Review):

Stop Work Order(s) and Order(s) to Comply: There are no outstanding Orders on file.

A Building Permit has not been issued. The Ontario Building Code requires a building permit for structures that exceed 10m².

The applicant shall be advised that additional variances may be required upon review of detailed drawing for building permit/site plan approval.

Development Planning:

Official Plan: City of Vaughan Official Plan 2010 ('VOP 2010'): "Low-Rise Residential"

The Owner is proposing to construct a swimming pool with the above-noted variances.

The subject property is an irregularly shaped lot, with a small easterly portion of the lot fronting directly onto Ellerby Square North, resulting in a condition where the north side of the property, where the pool is proposed to be located, is deemed to be a side yard.

The Development Planning Department can support the requested variance on the basis that the north side yard is effectively used as a rear yard and is similar in orientation to the adjacent properties along Ellerby Square North. The proposed swimming pool also complies with the rear yard and side yard setback requirements of Zoning By-law 1-88.

In support of the application, the Owner has submitted an Arborist Report and Tree Protection Plan, prepared by Canopy Consulting on August 12, 2021. The report identified 12 trees, with none proposed to be removed. Urban Design staff have reviewed the Arborist Report and concur with its recommendations.

The subject property is partially located within the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority ('TRCA') Regulated Area. The TRCA has reviewed the application and have no concerns with the proposed pool, as it is not located within the area of the subject property regulated by the TRCA.

Accordingly, the Development Planning Department of the opinion that the proposal is minor in nature, maintains the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law, and is desirable for the appropriate development of the land.

The Development Planning Department recommends approval of the application.


Location Map Plans & Sketches




VAUGHAN LOCATION MAP - A196/21

This letter acknowledges receipt of the above noted application circulated by the City of Vaughan, Committee of Adjustment. The materials were received by Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) on September 29, 2021. TRCA staff has reviewed the above noted application, and as per the "Living City Policies for Planning and Development within the Watersheds of the TRCA" (LCP), provides the following comments as part of TRCA's commenting role under the *Planning Act*; the Authority's delegated responsibility of representing the provincial interest on natural hazards encompassed by Section 3.1 of the *Provincial Policy Statement, 2020*; TRCA's Regulatory Authority under Ontario Regulation 166/06, *Development, Interference with Wetlands and Alterations to Shorelines and Watercourses*; and, our Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Region of York, wherein we provide technical environmental advice related to provincial plans.

Background

It is our understanding that the purpose of the above noted application is to request the following variance:

1. To permit a private swimming pool to be constructed in the side yard, whereas a private swimming pool shall be constructed only in the rear yard.

Ontario Regulation 166/06

The subject property is partially located within the TRCA's Regulated Area of the Humber River Watershed due to a valley corridor associated with a tributary of Humber River located to the north of the lot. In accordance with *Ontario Regulation 166/06 (Regulation of Development, interference with Wetlands and Alterations to Shorelines and Watercourses)*, development, interference or alteration may be permitted in the Regulated Area where it can be demonstrated to TRCA's satisfaction that the control of flooding, erosion, dynamic beaches, pollution, or the conservation of land will not be affected.

Application-Specific Comments

As noted above, a portion of the subject property is located within TRCA's Regulated Area. However, based on a review of the submitted materials, the proposed works are not located within TRCA's Regulated Area. As such, it is the opinion of TRCA staff that the current proposal will not impact any natural features or associated hazards and TRCA's policy interests are not affected. TRCA staff have no concerns with the proposed variance.

Fees

By copy of this letter, the applicant is advised that the TRCA has implemented a fee schedule for our planning application review services. This application is subject to a \$610.00 (Variance-Residential-Minor) review fee. The applicant is responsible for fee payment and should forward the application fee to this office as soon as possible.

Recommendation

Based on the above, TRCA staff have **no objection** to the approval of Minor Variance Application A196.21, subject to the following condition:

1. That the applicant provides the required fee amount of \$610.00 payable to the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority.
