Following the second review of the Minor Variance application, the City of Vaughan's GIS Archaeological mapping, the York Region Master Plan map for Ossuary Potential and the confirmation of remaining archaeological potential (located largely in the area identified as the future "Lot B") Cultural Heritage staff is revising its earlier recommendation to apply the Standard Archaeological Clause as the sole cultural heritage condition.

Please be advised that the application require an archaeological assessment of the existing subject property to confirm whether archaeological remains are present before the finalization of the severance application. The property will need to be confirmed to be free of archaeological concerns, along with a letter of review and acceptance from the Ministry. Both the report and the letter shall be forwarded to Cultural Heritage staff.
