Applicant Justification for Variances: *As provided by Applicant in Application Form	 The squaring of the house to match the existing corner points would result in exactly 45% coverage as per Zoning By-law 1-88. However the new Zoning By-law 001-2021calculates the coverage including the existing and the proposed roof overhangs. This in itself slates this project for COA for the reason of coverage. The owners are a young family with 4 children and it may grow in the future, therefore the program for the second floor was central to this design. In order to accomodate the needs of this family with regards to the children's bedrooms and bathrooms, we have enlarged the second floor by cantilevering it over the existing driveway. This design decision resulted in increasing the coverage by 1.5% as per the Zoning By-law 1-88. The conversion of the garage triggered clause 5 from T-8 form [the base of the side yard setback iregulations in both Zoning By-laws]. It stipulates an enlarged side yard or front yard setback if there is no garage attached to the dwelling. This creates our second variance regarding the setbacks despite keeping the existing setbacks for our ground floor and the second floor additions. The garage conversion is needed for creating a large mudroom as well as the garden shed storage. The existing back yard is already very small and it would be not recommended to install a garden shed there.


LOCATION MAP - A145/22
