In the strongest terms, I would like to state that I am appalled and opposed to the size and scope of the development project proposal for 8940 Bathurst. I am also extremely disappointed that the city would even consider such a submission given all the debate and contention that arose for the development of the lands next door at 9000 Bathurst. That debate fractured the neighboring community and should have been something by which the city learnt from. Instead, by even considering such a massive proposal, the city is showing indifference and perhaps even contempt for the neighborhood. This proposal of 2 large-story buildings plus 5 additional stacked townhome blocks on a much smaller size of land (vis-a-vis the 9000 Bathurst project) is simply outrageous and unacceptable. Not only does it deface the fabric and serenity of the neighborhood, but it also smacks of extreme hypocrisy and double standards. For this proposal to even be considered, it must be scaled back extensively and be in proportion to the density of the neighboring lands.
