Background

The request for proclamation was received from the Environmental Services Department on February 7, 2024.

World Water Day celebrates water and inspires action to tackle the global water crisis. Held on March 22 every year, World Water Day is observed by the United Nations and

focuses on the importance of fresh water. Environmental Services is requesting that the City of Vaughan proclaim this date on an annual basis going forward.

Council has granted this proclamation request in previous years.
