BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 030-2024

A By-law to amend Parking By-law 064-2019, as amended, to eliminate the prohibition for commercial vehicles to park on a residential lot, in accordance with the Zoning By-law 001-2021, as amended.

WHEREAS section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on a municipality to (a) enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and (b) enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS section 11(3) and 11(8) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide for lower-tier municipalities to pass by-laws respecting matters pertaining to highways, including parking and traffic on highways, and parking, except on highways;

AND WHEREAS staff seek to update the Parking By-law in accordance with the City’s Zoning By-law 001-2021, as amended, or its successor by-law, which allows commercial motor vehicles to park in residential zone subject to various conditions;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Amend Parking By-law 064-2019, as amended, to delete subsection 3.0(1)(h).
- 2. Amend Parking By-law 064-2019, as amended, to delete section 5.0(14).
- 3. Amend Parking By-law 064-2019, as amended, in Schedule 10 – Offences and Corresponding Administrative Monetary Penalties, to delete the following row:
