BY-LAW NUMBER 023-2024

A By-law to Stop and Close a portion of Doughton Road and a portion of Interchange Way as public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Council of a municipality has the power to enact a by-law permanently closing a highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands which are situate in the City of Vaughan, Regional Municipality of York, being the portion of Doughton Road and Interchange Way, legally described Part of Lot 5, Concession 5 (geographic Township of Vaughan), designated as Parts 14 and 15 on Reference Plan 65R-40282, respectively, be and is hereby stopped up and closed as public highway.
