


1851

James Wreggitt died in 1850, leaving his property to his two sons, George and Richard.

It has been observed in a handful of documents, that the last name 'Wreggitt' was found to be misspelled/misinterpreted from its original spelling.


For example, we see the spelling 'Pickett' in the 1851 map of Vaughan.

Dalziel (below Wreggitt property) seems to be taking care of the other portion of the Wreggitt property until Richard decides to sell.



1860

'Estate of Late James Wreggit' (another misspell) is listed on the Tremaine Map of 1860. It is unclear why George and Richard's names are not listed instead, especially since Tax Assessment records indicate that George was still active on his property.
