# *BY-LAW*

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 119-2024**

**A By-law of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend Short-Term Rental By-law 158-2019, as amended.**

**WHEREAS** section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25* (“*Municipal Act*”), as amended, provides that municipal powers shall be exercised by by-law;

**AND WHEREAS** section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act* provides that the powers of a municipality under the *Municipal Act* shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality’s ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** section 11(3) of the *Municipal Act* provides that a lower-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting business licensing;

**AND WHEREAS** Council has determined that it is desirable to make an amendment to Short-Term Rental By-law 158-2019;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Short-Term Rental By-law 158-2019, as amended, be further amended by adding the word “*Order,*” before the word “*notice*” in section 13.0(1).
