
Plan Overview

- ► The Community Spaces Plan (CSP) will strategically guide the future direction of Vaughan's parks, recreation, and library facilities.
- ▶ It will include implementation strategies for both the short term (next five years) and the long term (ten to twenty-five years).
- ► The CSP will replace the Active Together Master Plan (ATMP).
- ▶ We are targeting June 2025 for completion.



- ► The CSP is not a trails plan, but recognizes the importance of connecting people with spaces and in offering active pedestrian/cycling opportunities within parks
- ► This Advisory Committee can inform the CSP by:
 - identifying alignment opportunities with the Vaughan Transportation Plan, Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan, etc.
 - informing other areas of common interest



Today's Objective

- We want to gain a better understanding how we can align community space strategies with the transportation network and related initiatives.
- ► We're also exploring facility and service strategies for growing areas, including areas of intensification.





Topic #1: Barriers and Opportunities

Safety, infrastructure, connectivity, and awareness/culture were identified within the Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan as key barriers and opportunities for active transportation.

- A. How can Vaughan's parks, recreation, and library facilities be planned and designed to enhance opportunities for active transportation across the city?
- B. Conversely, what key transportation and active transportation initiatives may contribute to enhanced accessibility to Vaughan's community spaces?

Enhancing transportation networks in the VMC and other intensification areas has been identified as a priority.

- B. How can parks, recreation and library facilities be planned and designed to reflect these differences?
