<u>Purpose</u>

To seek approval for the above-noted proclamation requests for the month of March.

Background

Amyloidosis Awareness Month

Correspondence was received from the Canadian Amyloidosis Support Network (CASN) on January 5, 2025, making the request for proclamation.

The CASN is a federally registered non-profit organization that assists patients and families impacted by amyloidosis. As per information provided by CASN, amyloidosis refers to a group of diseases caused by deposits of abnormal proteins, known as amyloid, in one or more organs of the body causing organ impairment or failure.

Council has previously granted this request.

National Flower Day

Correspondence was received from the Parks, Forestry and Horticulture Operations at the City of Vaughan on January 14, 2025, making the request for proclamation.

National Flower Day is a day which invites everyone to appreciate the beauty and diversity of flowers, honour their vital role in our ecosystems, and explore the rich cultural meanings behind every bloom.

Epilepsy Awareness Month & Purple Day

The request for proclamation was received from Epilepsy York Region (EYR) on January 21, 2025. EYR is a non-profit organization which supports individuals and their families living with epilepsy. Over the past 37 years, EYR has been advocating, supporting, educating, promoting public awareness and developing programs.

The organization has also requested a flag raising, which will be reviewed by the City Clerk as per the City's Flag Protocol Policy (03.C.11).

Council has previously granted this request.
