## BY-LAW

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 052-2025**

A By-law to amend Discharge of Firearms By-law 123-2016, as amended, to reflect changes to the legislative authority for municipalities to appoint municipal by-law enforcement officers, update definitions and clarify interpretation of the By-law.

**WHEREAS** section 119 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality may, for the purpose of public safety, prohibit or regulate the discharge of guns or other firearms, air-guns, spring-guns, cross-bows, long-bows or any other weapon;

**AND WHEREAS** the City of Vaughan enacted Discharge of Firearms By-law 123-2016, in which various types of officers have the authority to enforce the By-law;

AND WHEREAS section 55 of the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019, S.O. 2019, c. 1, Sched. 1 ("Community Safety and Policing Act") gives municipalities the authority to appoint Municipal By-law Enforcement Officers and repeals and replaces the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 15 ("Police Services Act") which previously gave municipal councils that authority;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan deems it necessary to amend Discharge of Firearms By-law 123-2016, as amended, to reflect this change to legislative authority, and make other updates regarding definitions and interpretation of the By-law;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. To amend By-law 123-2016, as amended, as follows:
  - (a) renumber section 3.0(1) to 3.0(4);
  - (b) to delete the letter(s) beside each separate definition in section 3.0(4) and list all definitions in alphabetical order;
  - (c) to add sections 3.0(1) to 3.0(3) as follows:
    - (1) In this By-law, unless the context otherwise requires, words imparting the singular number shall include the plural, and words

- imparting the masculine gender shall include the feminine and further, the converse of the foregoing also applies where the context requires.
- (2) Wherever a word is used in this By-law with its first letter capitalized and the whole word italicized, the term is being used as it is defined in 3.0(4) of this By-law. Where any word appears in ordinary case, the commonly applied English language meaning is intended.
- (3) Any reference to a statute, regulation, by-law or other legislation shall include such statute, regulation, by-law or legislation as amended, re-enacted, replaced, or superseded.
- (d) delete reference to "as amended" and "as amended, or its equivalent in any successor by-law";
- (e) delete and replace the definition of *Municipal Law Enforcement Officer* with: "Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer" means a person appointed as a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer, pursuant to section 15 of the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15 or section 55 of the *Community Safety and Policing Act*, 2019, S.O. 2019, c. 1, Sched. 1, to enforce the provisions of this By-law;
- (f) delete and replace the text in section 5.0(1) with, "Notwithstanding section 4.0(1), a Police Officer, Conservation Officer, or *Animal Services Officer* may discharge a *Firearm* in the exercise of his or her duties."
- (g) delete and replace the text in section 7.0(1) with, "No person shall hinder or obstruct a *Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer, or* York Regional Police Officer from entering and inspecting all lands at any reasonable time for purposes of determining whether there is compliance with this By-law;
- (h) add the following definitions in section 3.0(4) in alphabetical order:"Animal Services Officer" includes:
  - (a) Municipal By-Law Enforcement Officers;
  - (b) Animal Services Manager(s) or Supervisor(s); and

(c) any other person authorized by the *Director*, such as persons under contract to or appointed by the *City*;

"Zoning By-law" refers to City Zoning By-law 001-2021;

(i) delete and replace reference to "Zoning By-law 1-88, as amended, or its equivalent in any successor by-law" with "Zoning By-law".
