## BY-LAW

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 100-2025**

A By-law to dedicate certain lands as part of the public highway and lift 0.3m Reserves from certain lands.

**WHEREAS** Section 31 of *the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* confers that land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law establishing the highway and not by the activities of the municipality or any other person in relation to the land.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the lands which are situated in the City of Vaughan, in the Regional Municipality of York, being Parts 1 to 3 inclusive, on Reference Plan 65R-40505, registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of York Region (No.65); be dedicated to form part of a public highway municipally known as "Lichen Court".
- 2. THAT the lands which are situated in the City of Vaughan, in the Regional Municipality of York, dedicated as 0.3m Reserves, legally described as Parts 3 & 4 on Reference Plan 65R-40505, be lifted as the 0.3m Reserves are no longer necessary.
- THAT the public highway dedication and the lifting of the Reserves shall be effective upon the registration of this By-law in the Land Registry Office of York Region (No.65).
