BY-LAW NUMBER 079-2026

A By-law to amend Parking By-Law 064-2019, to regulate the parking of motor vehicles on roads under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan.

WHEREAS sections 11(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the “*Municipal Act*”), as amended, provide for lower-tier municipalities to pass by-laws respecting matters pertaining to highways, including parking and traffic on highways, and parking, except on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan deems it necessary to add additional parking prohibitions on certain highways within its jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT City of Vaughan By-law 064-2019, as amended, be amended by adding the following provision to Schedule 1 — *No Parking*:

Highway	Side	From and to	Prohibited Time of Day
Gatineau Drive	Both	East limit of New Westminster Drive to a point 140m east of New Westminster Drive	Anytime

Amendment to the Comprehensive Parking By-law 064-2019, Gattineau Drive

Background

The City's Comprehensive Parking By-law 064-2019 regulates the parking of motor vehicles on roads under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan. As new streets and laneways are established through development in the City, it is necessary to amend Schedules in the Parking By-Law 064-2019 to include the parking and stopping prohibitions on these streets and laneways consistent with the pavement marking and signage plans approved as part of the development application review process. The Parking By-law 064-2019 will be amended as development proceeds on a regular basis going forward.

This By-law amendment captures the parking prohibition along Gattineau Drive, between New Westminster Drive and future Margolis Drive, approximately 140m east of New Westminster Drive, as shown on Attachment No. 2, to maintain safe and efficient traffic flow, support emergency vehicle access, and prevent congestion caused by parked vehicles occupying travel lanes. This parking by-law update will form the amendment to Parking By-law 064-2019, Schedule 1 — No Parking.

In accordance with the authority granted in By-law 144-2018, staff are recommending that the City enact a by-law, amending the Parking By-law, as amended, to reflect the above noted changes.
