BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 153-2019

A By-law to amend Fees and Charges By-law 171-2013, as amended, and to amend Special Events By-law 045-2018, as amended.

WHEREAS Council authorized the consolidation and harmony of regulatory by-laws;

WHEREAS Council also authorized amendments intended to ensure standardization and clarity, especially in enforcement powers and penalties, including consequential amendments to other by-laws;

WHEREAS these amendments included amending Special Events By-law 045-2018, as amended, by deleting Schedule “A”, special event permit fees and adding the fees to consolidated Fees and Charges By-law 171-2013, as amended, Schedule “I”, under By-law & Compliance Services;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan **ENACTS**

AS FOLLOWS:

1. That City of Vaughan By-law number 045-2018, as amended, be further amended by deleting Schedule “A”, Special Event Permit Fees; and
2. That Fees & Charges By-law 171-2013, as amended, be further amended by adding the following Special Event Permit Fees to Schedule “I”, under By-law & Compliance Services:

Special Event Permit and deposit costs based on maximum attendance*	2019	2020	HST
Special event permit – up to 250 people	\$ 53	\$ 55	E
Special event permit – up to 500 people	\$ 106	\$ 109	E
Special event permit – up to 1,000 people	\$ 212	\$ 218	E
Special event permit – more than 1,000 people	\$ 424	\$ 437	E
Special event damage deposit – up to 250 people	\$ 1,000	\$ 1,000	E
Special event damage deposit – up to 500 people	\$ 2,500	\$ 2,500	E
Special event damage deposit – up to 1,000 people	\$ 5,000	\$ 5,000	E
Special event damage deposit – more than 1,000 people	\$ 10,000	\$ 10,000	E

Note: All Fees are before HST. E = HST Exempt, Y = HST Applicable. The City reserves the right to review HST applicability for any regulatory or legislative changes.
