BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 168-2019

A By-law of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend Noise By-law 062-2018, as amended.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, Section 129. (1) Paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 authorize municipalities to pass by-laws to prohibit and regulate Noise;

AND WHEREAS it is in the public interest to reduce the Noise level in the City of Vaughan, so as to preserve, protect, and promote public health, safety, welfare, and the peace and quiet of the inhabitants of the City;

AND WHEREAS it is the policy of the Council of The Corporation of City of Vaughan to regulate such Sound or vibration, or nuisance;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Noise By-law 062-2018, as amended, by further amended by:
 - (a) replacing the definition for “Special Events” in Section 3 with the following definition:

“Special Event” means an event as defined in the Special Events By-law, as amended, or its successor by-law.
 - (b) amending Section 17(2) to read:

The provisions of this By-law shall not apply to preclude musicians or performers providing outdoor entertainment involving sound reproduction devices during City events.
