# ***BY-LAW***

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 177-2019**

**A By-law of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend By-law 169-2017 by deleting provisions that provide for transit bus pick-up and drop-off on New Park Place.**

**WHEREAS** section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on a municipality to (a) enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and (b) enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** section 11(3) and 11(8) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide for lower-tier municipalities to pass by-laws respecting matters pertaining to highways, including parking and traffic on highways, and parking, except on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** the SmartCentres Place Bus Terminal was completed in November of 2019 and come into full operation and temporary parking regulations to accommodate the bus terminal are no longer required;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan deems the regulation of parking and the creation of pick-up and drop-off areas necessary to ensure the safety of drivers and pedestrians, and the effective flow of traffic in the Mobility Hub of the VMC;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 169-2017 be amended by deleting section 3.
