










New Policies

VAUGHAN FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE TRAINING DIVISION

PPE (personal protective equipment) Quick Reference Guide

Important: Provide self with appropriate physical distancing before donning/doffing

- Balance urgency to provide patient care with the need for careful donning/doffing of appropriate PPE

All Medical Calls (Verify Patient Contact History (Negative COVID Screening))

What?	Droplet or Contact
When?	Routine Care (verbal assessment, questioning)
Primary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> N95 or Half Mask Respirator (200 or 400) or SCBA Goggles Gloves Remain at least 2 metres away from patient.
Crew	If not required → remain outside the immediate area. If required → don same level as first FF
Patient (Reverse Isolation)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask patient to don a surgical mask without contact Maintaining social distancing


